ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE OF BERWICK TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION V OF ORDINANCE NO. 2 (ADOPTED JANUARY 1, 1983) WHICH ESTABLISHES THE PERSON CHARGED WITH THE ENFORCEMENT OF SAID ORDINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by Berwick Township, Adams County,

Pennsylvania, and by its authority The Board of Supervisors hereby ordains:

Section One. Amendment of Existing Ordinance. Section V of the existing

Ordinance is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"Section V. Enforcement. The Tax Collector of the Township of Berwick or other person designated by the Township is hereby charged with the enforcement of this Ordinance."

Section Two. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are hereby

repealed.

Section Three. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be, unconstitutional illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein. Section Four. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective live days after its enactment.
