

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE OF BERWICK TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE FOR JOINT AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE REGIONAL'S POLICE SERVICES TO THE BOROUGH OF NEW OXFORD, ADAMS COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Oxford Township and Berwick Township have entered into a cooperative agreement to provide police services to the citizens of both jurisdictions through the formation of the Regional; and

WHEREAS, said agreement was established by separate ordinance of Oxford Township and Berwick Township; said Berwick Township Ordinance being effective of March 11, 1991 by the Berwick Township Board of Supervisors and known as Berwick Township Ordinance No. 20; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance, upon Oxford Township adopting a similar ordinance, created the Regional as of December 3, 1991; and

WHEREAS, said Regional provides protection and safety for all the persons within both Townships; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of New Oxford, Adams County, Pennsylvania, is desirous of entering into an agreement for the Regional to extend its police services within the jurisdiction of the Borough of New Oxford; and

WHEREAS, Berwick Township desires to enter into an agreement with the Borough of New Oxford, Adams County, for the extension of the Regional's police services to the Borough of New Oxford, Adams County, Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, TILE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
BERWICK, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, HEREBY ORDAINS THE
FOLLOWING:

Section 1: Berwick Township hereby enters into a joint agreement for law enforcement services for the extension of the Regional's police services to the Borough of New Oxford, Adams County, Pennsylvania.

Section 2: The ability of the Township to enter into the joint agreement for law enforcement services is granted through the authority of Inter-Governmental Cooperation Act of July 12, 1972, 180 (53 P.S. §481, et. seq.).


Section 3: Nothing in this ordinance shall supersede the Berwick Township Ordinance No. 20 passed and made effective March 11, 1991 creating the Eastern Adams Regional Police Department.

Section 4: The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable. If any provision hereof shall be held to be unconstitutional, invalid or illegal, by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining sections or parts of sections of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as a legislative intent of the Board of Supervisors, that this ordinance would have been enacted had such unconstitutional, invalid or illegal provision not been included herein.

Section 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, with exception of the aforementioned Ordinance No. 20.


