ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BERWICK TOWNSHIP
ZONING ORDINANCE OF APRIL, 1999

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Berwick Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 702(E) of the Berwick Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by changing the Minimum Off-Street Parking Space Requirements for Quick Serve (Fast-food) Restaurant to the following:


1 Space for every 3 seats of design capacity or 1 space for every 50 square feet of dining and ordering floor area, whichever is larger; plus 1 space for every 2 employees on the largest shift.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment.
