ORDINANCE NO. 61 AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 56

(Adopted October 22, 2001)

Be it enacted and ordained by Berwick Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania,

and by its authority, by the Board of Supervisors hereby enacts and ordains:

SECTION I. Section III.3.D. of Ordinance No. 56 reads as follows:

Gas stations and garages are required to provide oil interceptors of the types Series GA, GX, GNC, GRC of Josam Manufacturing Company, Michigan City, Indiana, or equivalent, in the proper location, where the dangerous liquids are to be intercepted.

Restaurants or other Commercial Establishments as directed are required to provide a complete grease recovery unit, properly sized to handle anticipated flow rates as manufactured by Lowe Engineering Company, Thermanco, Inc. or equivalent.

SECTION II. Section III. 3.D. of Ordinance No. 56 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Gas stations and garages are required to provide oil interceptors of the types Series GA, GX, GNC, GRC of Josam Manufacturing Company, Michigan City, Indiana, or equivalent, in the proper location, where the dangerous liquids are to be intercepted.

Restaurants or other Commercial Establishments are required to provide a complete grease recovery unit, properly sized to handle anticipated flow rates as manufactured by Lowe Engineering Company, Thermanco, Inc. or equivalent.

All owners of gas stations, garages, restaurants or other commercial establishments shall submit to the Township a Grease Trap/Interceptor/ Separator Application as provided for in Attachment A along with the plans, specifications and other pertinent information relating to the proposed facilities for pretreatment and handling of waste, along with the required fee as may be set from time to time by Resolution of the Township. No construction of any such facility shall be commenced until a permit is obtained from the Township and any other governmental entity having jurisdiction.

All such facilities (Grease Traps, Interceptors, Separators, etc.) shall be continuously maintained, at the expense of the owner, in satisfactory operating condition. The owner shall provide to the Township not less than quarterly a "Grease Interceptor Cleaning Record Verification Form" as is provided in Attachment A.

SECTION III.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV.

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is found to be for any reason unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionally, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance.

SECTION V.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.

Confidential Business Information

Information and data on a user obtained from reports, questionnaires, permit applications, permits and monitoring programs and from inspections shall be available to the public or other governmental agency without restriction unless the user specifically requests and is able to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the township that the release of such information would divulge information, processes or methods of production is entitled to protection as trade secrets of the user. When requested by the person furnishing a report, the portions of a report which might disclose trade secrets or secret processes shall not be made available for inspection by the public but shall be made available upon request to governmental agencies for uses related to this ordinance, Information accepted by the Township as confidential shall not be transmitted to the

general public by the Township until and unless a ten-day notification is given to the user. In order for the information to be considered confidential, the following criteria must be met:

- A separate sheet with the requested information shall be submitted for each question that you are asserting as confidential.
- The submittal shall be clearly marked as confidential.
- Submit with the application a separate statement for each question that you are requesting confidentiality indicating the reasons that you are asserting the information as confidential. You will be notified if the Township does not feel that the information requested meets the criteria for confidentiality.

Authorized Representative Statement

I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted in the attached document, and I hereby certify under penalty of law that this information was obtained in accordance with the requirements of Ordinance No. 56 of the Sanitary Sewer Regulations. Moreover, based upon my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information reported herein, I believe that the submitted information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete the attached permit application.
2. Include a signed copy of your grease hauling contract.
3. Provide the appropriate yearly fee based on the table below. Add the volumes of all grease traps, interceptors, and separators located at the facility being permitted, and send in the fee based on the total volume.

Volume (in gallons) of All Grease Traps/Interceptors/Separators

<u>Total Gallons</u>	<u>Yearly Fee</u>
0-49	\$50
50-999	\$100
1,000-4,999	\$200

Examples: A facility with 1-10 gal. trap and 1-25 gal. trap (35 gallons total): \$50
A facility with 2-50 gal. traps and a 750 gal. interceptor (850 gallons total): \$100
A facility with 2-50 gal. traps and a 3,000 gal. interceptor (3,100 gallons total): \$200

4. Provide schematic drawings of all indoor and outdoor plumbing systems, including grease interceptors and traps, facility sewer connections, sinks, floor drains, dishwashers, rest rooms, etc.
5. Provide a grease trap/interceptor maintenance plan that specifies the frequency of grease removal, inspection procedures, and methods to repair non-operable equipment.

7. The Township will contact you for initial inspection time. Routine inspections will be performed by the Township on an ongoing basis at no additional fees. Noncompliant owners resulting in additional inspections may be assessed additional fees.


