

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING, ORDAINING, AND NAMING  
AS A PUBLIC STREET OF BERWICK TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, THE ROADWAY KNOWN AS ORCHARD DRIVE, BEING  
WITH THE ORCHARD ACRES SUBDIVISION.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by Berwick Township,  
Adams County, Pennsylvania, and the Board of Supervisors,  
by its authority upon a finding that it is necessary  
for the promotion of the public good and welfare of  
the Township to add the following road to the highway  
system of Berwick Township, do hereby enact and ordain  
as follows:

Section One. Dedication as a Public Street. There  
is ordained as a public street, road, and highway the  
following roadway which is to be made a part of the  
public road system of Berwick Township:

The roadway known as Orchard Drive, as is more  
particularly described in a Deed conveyed by Charles  
W. Test and Ingeborg G. Test, of Berwick Township, Adams  
County, Pennsylvania, to Berwick Township, dated September  
24, 1991, a copy thereof attached hereto and incorporated  
herein as exhibit "A".

Section Two. Filing. The Township Secretary is directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance, together with a draft of said street, in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Adams County, Pennsylvania.

Section Three. Valid Date. This Ordinance shall become effective within five days of its enactment.


