BERWICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WORKSHOP SEPTEMBER 2, 2022

<u>CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG</u> – The Berwick Township Board of Supervisors held a Workshop on September 2, 2022 at 8:30 a.m. in the Municipal Building, 85 Municipal Road, Hanover, to discuss the Fall Fest, and any other business which may come before the Board. Present were Supervisors Pete Socks, Tom Danner, Earle Black, Barry Cockley, Scott Kennedy, KPI Technology Ryan Picarelli, Secretary Jean Hawbaker.

PUBLIC COMMENT (AGENDA ITEMS) - None.

BUSINESS

 Stanley and Little – Road widening – Tom Danner explained that this project star Stanley Drive and Kelly Road, and we do not want to go outside of that scope. We had a meeting on site yesterday to discuss the project and drainage issues. The homeowner to the left is objecting to putting a culvert on their property to resolve the drainage problem, and we were also going to widen that side of the road. We need to look at the most feasible way, and also protects the township.

Ryan Picarelli explained they discussed moving the inlet to the right and tie in to the inlet in that location, and then we could also within the same lineal feet run a piece of pipe under the road to the property owner on the left. There is a bush that can be removed on the Herb property since he also agrees it be removed.

Tom Danner made a motion to authorize KPI Technology to move the inlet to the right side, and taking that widening area back to the curb with the understanding that the homeowner is in agreement with removing that bush, and get pricing for an additional inlet for the property on the left, seconded by Barry Cockley. <u>Saw cart purchase</u> – Pete Socks made a motion to authorize purchasing a saw cart in the amount of \$1,082.00 from Advanced Concrete Technology, seconded by Barry Cockley. Roll Call: Black – yes, Cockley – yes, Socks – yes, Danner – yes, Kennedy – yes. Motion carried.

The township should take core samples so it can be verified. Tom Danner made a motion authorizing Tim Shultis and Tim Knoebel to initiate the process to document the claim against H&H relative to the imperfections in Kinneman North, seconded by Scott Kennedy. **Roll Call: Black – yes, Cockley – yes, Socks – yes, Danner – yes, Kennedy – yes. Motion carried**.

Tom Danner made a motion to authorize KPI Technology to arrange for the core sampling to be done, seconded by Barry Cockley. **Roll Call: Black – yes, Cockley – yes, Socks – yes, Danner – yes, Kennedy – yes. Motion carried.**

KINNEMAN ROAD DISCUSSION

Ryan Picarelli explained Kinneman Road up to Lobell Road is split between the township and Abbottstown Borough. On the east side of Kinneman North you already had your established curb and on the west side we widened and added curb. The problem we are seeing is more on the township's side than on the Borough's side. Tom Danner stated it will be checked on the township's side and the borough's side.
